Need to Register for the Tobacco Citation Class?

FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

I have a tobacco citation – where do I sign up for a class?

The site a student will need to visit is www.FLTobaccoPrevention.org. This site is where the student registers and begins the course. The course is accessible 24/7.

Is there a fee?

No, this course is free.

What can I expect from the course?

The course is very interactive and usually takes about 3.5 hours to complete. The student must reach the required score to receive the completion certificate.

How do I get my certificate?

That certificate comes directly from the programs and will be emailed directly to the student/parent once completed. Please use an email when registering that is not school related as it works best for correspondence.

Why did I not receive my certificate?

First, the course has a required score to achieve and receive the completion certificate. If you do not reach that score, you will not receive a certificate. Second, if you sign up with a school address, you may not be able to receive emails from persons and organizations outside of Charlotte County Public Schools, even if your citation was received at school. This is an internal safety mechanism of the schools. Please use another email address, such as a parent's email address.

Is there any technical support available from the site?

The course is sponsored by the Department of Health, has convenient 24/7 Online Access and a dedicated team to handle any technical issues. Technical support may be subject to the usual working hours.
